Why Romania?



Romania is the most dynamic large market in Europe, a strong democracy, a NATO and EU member. After a GDP growth of 4.8% in 2016, in Q1 and Q2 2017 Romania registered the highest GDP growth rate in the EU: 5.7%.

With unemployment average of 5.5%, the purchasing power of the Romanian population increased with 12% in 2016 and the consumption with 9%.



Additional to the local consumption growth and increasing purchasing power, Romania's strategic advantage is its position as a GATEWAY to the EU, on one hand, and to large markets such as Russia, Turkey, Ukraine, Kazakhstan that are not part of the EU.

FRD Center has direct contact with relevant local players in the medical devices and health equipment sector, both importer-distributors and direct buyers.



Medical Devices Market in Romania



The Romanian Medical Equipment market, currently estimated at some EUR 500 million, is 90% generated by imports and offers opportunities for foreign manufacturers to export to Romania.

In the next 3-5 years, it is expected to grow by approx 5% y-o-y, mainly due to Romania's economic growth and increasing health expenditure both by the Government and private consumers.

There are approximately 300 medical device distributors and commercial representatives in Romania. FRD Center has extensive specialised d-base of relevant contacts in the medical devices and health equipment sector, of both importer-distributors and direct buyers.




Orthopaedic Implants and Medical Devices Market in Romania



Orthopedic Implants used in Romania are imported. The orthopaedic or fracture appliances imports in Romania (TARIC 902110) registered in 2015 an increase of 12.2% compared to 2014. In 2016, they reached EUR 8.4m.



Medical Technologies International also imports and distributes a wide range of medical devices, including vascular laser and cardiovascular surgery devices.



The company is also a major player in the category of products for arthroscopy, sports medicine and equipment dedicated to the operating room and medical offices.

The company has partnerships with over 30 leading global manufacturers, including Zimmer – leader in the field of orthopedic implants, Leica Microsystems, Wright Medical, SRA Developments, Moor Instruments, KCI an Acelity Company, DJO Global, Anika Therapeutics.

In 2016, Medical Technologies International SRL registered a turnover of almost EUR 17m, which according to the FRD Center analysis is 31.7% higher than in 2015.

Founded in 1997 by two orthopaedic surgeons, MEDICAL ORTOVIT is currently a leading provider of orthopaedic implants and other high-tech treatments in Romania. They import and distribute osteosynthesis devices, rods, tiles, articular prosthesis, arthroscopic equipment and devices etc.

Their international suppliers include Smith & Nephew, Fournitures Hospitalieres, Groupe Lepine, Geistlich Surgery, Reda, Kinetec, Amedrix, Medline, ChM etc.

With the contribution of a team of 50 employees, Medical Ortovit can provide advanced therapeutic solutions for orthopedic patients and for a wider range of other pathologies.

In 2016, Medical Ortovit registered a turnover of EUR 6.1m, which according to the FRD Center analysis is 6.9% lower than in 2015.

Set up in 1992, SILVA TRADING entered the field of high-tech medical products in 1997 with the import and distribution of interventional cardiology products. In 1998, Silva Trading became exclusive distributor in Romania of MEDTRONIC.

In respect to orthopaedic implants, the company imports and distributes:

- cervical, lumbar disc prostheses, cervical disc replacement
- vertebral body replacements
- spine fixation systems through laparoscopy, endoscopy
- bone replacement

Founded in 1997, BIOTECHNIC is a Romanian medical device importer-distributor, specialized in joint replacement products.

The Company imports and distributes medical devices in Romania, especially hip and knee prostheses, colonic surgery systems and orthopaedic implants, including bone tumour reconstruction prostheses.

One of their international partners is Waldemar Link from which they import and distribute the Megasystem-C system. Other partners are C2F Implants and Biotechni (France),
